A limited amount of financial aid for tuition is available for Pre-Professional Division students ages 10 and up. Students are expected to study exclusively at Ballet Guild of the Lehigh Valley/Pennsylvania Youth Ballet, must take the maximum number of classes for his/her level to be considered for this type of assistance, and must perform in all BGLV productions, including the annual Nutcracker in December and the annual spring ballet. A parent and/or the student is expected to volunteer on a regular basis.

The Ballet Guild reserves the right to withdraw scholarship aid for failure to fulfill the terms of this agreement or for violation of the student etiquette code as stated in the Student Handbook. To be considered for financial assistance for the 2018-2019 school year, which also includes the 2019 summer dance program, this form must be completed and returned to our office by September 30, 2018.
