## THE NUTCRACKER FOR STUDENTS



#### Who...

Each year, approximately 4,000 area students thrill to the magic of our live production of *The Nutcracker*. Students are drawn from Northampton, Lehigh, Bucks, Berks, Montgomery, Carbon, Monroe, Luzerne and Schuylkill counties, PA; and Hunterdon and Mercer counties, NJ. Approximately 1,000 students in schools with a large concentration of low-income families attend for free. An additional 3,000 students receive heavily discounted tickets.

#### What...

The Nutcracker for Students, directed by Karen Kroninger Knerr, artistic director, is a unique arts education experience with student dancers and nationally-known guest artists; the Southside Sinfonietta, a 48-piece orchestra that performs the full score directed by Eugene Albulescu, music director; and school choirs. Performed at Zoellner Arts Center, The Nutcracker for Students will take place December 7-9, 2022. During intermission, guest artists take part in an informal curtain talk to discuss the production and ballet. A select number of students are invited on stage to participate in a ballet demonstration. A study guide, aligned to PA Academic Standards for the Arts and Humanities, helps teachers extend this arts education experience.
