He studied on a Ford Foundation Scholarship at The School of American Ballet (SAB) and American Ballet Theater School (ABT) and joined New York City Ballet where he worked under the direction of George Balanchine, Jerome Robbins and Peter Martins. Mr. Fox danced with The San Francisco Ballet as a Principal Dancer under Helgi Tomasson. He has performed principal roles including George Balanchine's Divertimento #15, Symphony in C, Serenade, Fancy Four Temperaments, and



Free, Four Seasons (original cast), and Interplay by Jerome Robbins. He has done works by Jiri Kylian, Arthur Mitchell, Val Caniporoli, Michael Smuin (Romeo & Juliet) and Paul Taylor's Sunset. Mr. Fox is grateful to have had teachers like Stanley Williams, Andre Kramarevsky, Alexandra Danilova, and Suki Schorer.
