#### BALLET CLASSES FOR ALL AGES AND ABILITIES

Our teachers foster a positive and supportive learning environment in each class, where students will be encouraged to build confidence through accomplishments in dance. To meet the needs of our students, we offer classes through our two-division system: Pre-Professional and Community.

Students in both divisions may audition for our yearly production of *The Nutcracker* at Zoellner Arts Center, Lehigh University, as well as our annual Spring Ballet, and other productions that may occur throughout the year.

Progressing Ballet Technique (PBT) classes have been added for students in the Pre-Professional Divisions. This revolutionary supplementary dance training will sharpen technical precision and includes exercises to strengthen core stability, muscle control, and balance.

#### PRE-PROFESSIONAL DIVISION

This intense course of study is designed for the serious dance student with previous ballet experience. Placement of all students in this division is determined by audition. Classes emphasize the development of ballet skills with a focus on knowledge, proper placement, and alignment. Students will learn ballet vocabulary through barre and centre work while building stamina, strength, flexibility, and musicality.

In addition to Pointe work, classes in Variations, Repertoire, and Jazz are also given.

Master classes, taught by professional teachers and dancers, will be held throughout the year for students in this Division. In addition, various performance opportunities are offered each year in our service to the community.

#### **COMMUNITY DIVISION**

Classes are offered for ages three through adult. The youngest students begin with an introduction to the basics of ballet; these include rhythm, dynamics, and terminology. Youth level classes are offered for the student who wishes to learn ballet or improve his/her technique without the commitment required in the Pre-Professional Division.

Students ages six & up also have the opportunity to audition for Ballet Guild productions. Adults with dance experience will find our classes fulfilling and will gain a greater sense of well-being while learning a method of exercise that will last a lifetime.

#### DIRECTOR AND STAFF

#### KAREN KRONINGER KNERR · ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Artistic Director since 2007, Karen holds a BFA in Dance from the Juilliard School where she trained in Graham, Taylor, and Limon techniques. She was a principal dancer with the Albany Berkshire Ballet, where she performed lead roles in *Cinderella, Coppélia*, as well as "Girl At Mirror" for the opening of the Norman Rockwell Museum in Stockbridge, MA. In addition, Karen was a member of the Ellen Sinopoli Dance Company.

She has worked with, and performed works by, Dennis Nahat, Laura Dean, Francis Patrelli, and Bill T. Jones. Karen holds an Intermediate Certification in Labanotation and is an ABT Certified Teacher. She has developed the outreach program, "Discover Dance" for the Ballet Guild of the Lehigh Valley. Karen teaches students from beginner level to advanced level for BGLV and has choreographed various works including Youth programs for the Allentown Symphony.
