Peter LeBreton Merz is the Regional Tour Director for the American Dance Competition, as well as a ballet master teacher, invited to teach at studios throughout the US. He has choreographed scores of ballets, ranging from solo works for students to larger ensembles for professional companies. He has won several awards for his choreography, including being named Outstanding Choreographer on many occasions by the Youth America Grand Prix. While his ballets are rooted heavily in classical technique, they also rely heavily on his passion for contemporary dance. His aesthetic seeks to explore the boundaries of the classical vocabulary, and to keep this idiom vital for today's audiences.



Peter is known as a master teacher for his enthusiastic and encouraging approach to ballet training. He has had the pleasure to teach master classes and at summer intensives to thousands of students, both here and abroad. His approach to classical training is to concentrate on helping each student find the strength that comes from understanding how best to place themselves, to maximize their expressive voices through the pursuit of clear and articulate technique.
