## **TERMS**

**\$10.00 per student; 1 teacher free with every 20 students. Reservations will be taken strictly on a first-come, first-served basis.** Priority is given to past ticket purchasers—Order Early! Please have only one person from each school handle reservations. Advise promptly of any changes in the number attending. Confirmation of your seating arrangements will be made once non-refundable deposit is received. No tickets are issued. Please save this announcement — it will be the only mailing. It's very important that we have a home or cell phone for your contact person in case of emergency or changes.

**A minimum deposit of 50% of total is due when reserving to hold seats. We can accept checks or credit cards for payment.** If you wish to use a credit card, email the completed order form to the PYB office ([pyb@rcn.com](mailto:pyb@rcn.com)). A PayPal invoice will be sent to the address provided—you will then access the link on the invoice and make your secure credit card payment yourself.

**Balance must be paid in full by October 1, 2026.** We can accept reservations up to the date of the performance; however, seat preferences will be limited AFTER October 15, 2026 – Please order early!

## **PERFORMANCE CANCELLATIONS**

In the event a performance must be canceled, we will make every effort to reschedule. If the performance takes place, there will be NO Refunds for No-Shows. Our policy is “the show must go on” if at all possible. If your school is closed due to inclement weather and the show takes place, a credit will be issued for the following year’s performance.

## **RESERVATION CHANGES**

We need your final reservation numbers no later than October 15, 2026 These should accompany your final payment. Please notify us if you wish to add additional seats no later than December 1, 2026. If you are bringing handicapped students who may need special seating, please let us know how many you will need.
